Juan Martin del Potro made his return to tennis Tuesday night after an 11-month hiatus and earned his first win in more than a year. He defeated American Denis Kudla 6-1, 6-4 in a match where the outcome was never in question. Del Potro last appeared in Delray Beach in 2011,
