DEL POTRO DREAM CONTINUES: SEMIS NEXT

The Argentine takes on American Sam Querrey



Juan Martin del Potro did not expect to play three matches in Delray Beach, his first tournament after missing 11 months due to injury. But now he will play four; he has cruised through three opponents without losing a set, the latest casualty No. 5 seed and world No. 30 Jeremy Chardy on Friday night (6-2, 6-3). He has yet to drop a single set in his eight career victories in Delray Beach. Del Potro takes on American Sam Querrey who won arguably the match of the tournament, beating fellow countryman Tim Smyczek 6-7(1), 7-6(4), 6-4.

DIMITROV, RAM MEET IN SEMIFINALS

Tournament No. 4 Dimitrov meets veteran American Ram



No. 4 seed Grigor Dimitrov is the highest seed remaining in the draw as he advanced to the semifinals in his first Delray Beach Open. He defeated world No. 49 Adrian Mannarino of France in straight sets Friday afternoon and will face world No. 89 Rajeev Ram who continues

his winning ways in Delray Beach. Ram, 31, defeated 34-year-old German Benjamin Becker in three sets Friday. Dimitrov and Ram will play at 3 pm Saturday.

BRYANS REACH THIRD STRAIGHT SEMI

No. 1-seeded brothers look for fifth Delray Beach title



The Bryan Brothers, the most decorated doubles pair in the world, are on the road to their third straight and fifth overall doubles title in Delray Beach. The No. 1 seed Bryans take on Jeremy Chardy of France and Leander Paes of India. The Bryans advanced to the semis

via walkover, while the Chardy / Paes pair advanced after winning a super tiebreak. Chardy and Paes are playing as a team in their third tournament of 2016. Paes, a former world No. 1, owns 55 career doubles titles and is in his 26th year on the ATP World Tour. Chardy has 3 ATP World Tour doubles titles.

HUEY / MIRNYI ARE NO. 3 SEED

Only other seeded pair to advance to semifinals



No. 3 seed Treat Huey of the Philippines and Max Mirnyi of Belarus have advanced to the semifinals. Both are ranked among the Top 40 doubles players in the world with the 38-year-old Mirnyi one of the most decorated doubles players with 48 titles. The pair, who

have won all their matches in straight sets, take on Austrian Oliver Marach and Frenchman Fabrice Martin - another pair yet to drop a set in the tournament.

RAVEN KLAASEN MEETS WITH BALL KIDS
