IF YOU GO: DELRAY BEACH OPEN QUICK FACTS (February 12-21)

When: ATP Champions Tour Event: Friday, Feb. 12 - Sunday, Feb. 14
Starts @ 6:00 pm Friday, 12:30 pm Saturday, 12:30 pm Sunday
ATP World Tour Qualifying: Saturday, Feb. 13 - Sunday, Feb. 14
Starts @ 11:00 am Saturday, 11:00 am Sunday
ATP World Tour Event: Monday, Feb. 15 - Sunday, Feb. 21
Starts @ 11:00 am Monday - Friday, 1:00 pm Saturday (semifinals)
Sunday Finals @ 1:00 pm (doubles) & 3:00 pm (singles)

Where: The Delray Beach Stadium & Tennis Center, 201 W. Atlantic Avenue. I-95 exit 52 (Atlantic Ave), Florida Turnpike: Exit 81 (Atlantic Ave). Head east using either exit and look for the tournament signs.

Who: The ATP World Tour field is led by a pair of Top 20 players in 2012 champion **Kevin Anderson** (No. 14) and **Bernard Tomic** (No. 20), plus former world No. 4 and 2011 Delray Beach champion **Juan Martin del Potro**, defending champion **Ivo Karlovic** (No. 26), **Grigor Dimitrov** (No. 28) and the defending champions **Bryan Brothers** doubles team. The ATP Champions Tour field includes six "legends of the game" in a USA vs International format. The USA team includes **Mardy Fish, James Blake & Aaron Krickstein** vs the International trio of **Sebastien Grosjean, Wayne Ferreira** and **Emilio Sanchez**.

TV Coverage: The ATP World Tour event will be televised domestically on Tennis Channel and internationally in more than 110 countries. The broadcasts start Monday, Feb. 15 and runs through the finals on Sunday, Feb. 21.

Admission: Ticket prices range from \$29 to \$85 for individual seats. Tournament packages, Weekender packages, on-court Best Seats in the House and covered Stadium Veranda seating are also available. Sky Suites seating eight (8) patrons are available for some sessions. Tickets can be purchased by phone (561-330-6000), on YellowTennisBall.com, or at the on-site box office.

Gates: Open an hour before play, with the exception of those holding passes or tickets for on-site special events.

Parking: \$5 in South County Courthouse Parking Garage (Atlantic & SW 2nd Ave) or Old School Square Parking Garage (Entrance on NE 1st Ave), Valet Parking \$20. \$10 discounted valet parking available for Porsche drivers.

Downtown Roundabout Trolley: Service runs between the Delray Beach Tri-Rail station and the tournament weekdays (Monday through Friday) from 6:00 am to 11:15 pm and on weekends (Saturday and Sunday) from 8:00 am to 11 pm. The trolley stops near the tournament entrance on W. Atlantic Ave.

Traffic: Fans can use the toll-free 511 Traveler Information Service, visit FL511.com or check the free Florida 511 mobile app to get traffic updates when heading to the tournament.

Security/Items Disallowed: The general public may be subject to bag searches. No backpacks, coolers or outside food or drink permitted on the premises.

Umbrellas: Umbrellas are permitted on-site, but the use of umbrellas is NOT permitted in the stadium or in outside court seating areas.

About The Delray Beach Open: The only tournament in the world featuring an [ATP Champions Tour](#) event and an [ATP World Tour](#) event in the same week at the same venue is held in [Delray Beach, Florida](#) February 12-21 at the [Delray Beach Stadium & Tennis Center](#). The ATP World Tour's first North American hard court event of the outdoor season is one of just 10 ATP World Tour events in the United States. In 2016 it will be celebrating its 24th year overall and 18th in Delray Beach. The ATP Champions Tour event is in its 7th year and was the first-ever event played on US soil. Each year the [Delray Beach Open](#) brings world-class tennis players and thousands of visitors to Delray Beach and [Palm Beach County](#). In 2010, the tournament received the [Discover The Palm Beaches Florida's](#) annual [Providencia Award](#) for its extraordinary contribution to tourism. The City of Delray Beach was also a finalist for the USTA's "Best Tennis Town" Award and in 2003, the tournament was the recipient of an "ATP Award of Excellence."
