QUERREY KNOCKS OFF DEL POTRO

All-American final set: Querrey takes on Ram



American Sam Querrey knocked off Juan Martin del Potro 7-5, 7-5 to secure a spot in the final against fellow countryman Rajeev Ram. Del Potro has dominated the headlines as he made his return after an 11-month hiatus here in Delray Beach, but Querrey played a solid game and did not give del Potro a break point opportunity. The 28-year-old Las Vegas resident is looking for his eighth career title and first since winning in Los Angeles in 2012. In that tournament, he defeated Ram, his opponent Sunday in Delray Beach, in the semifinals. Querrey has two other victories over Ram: 2009 in Indianapolis and 2010 in Memphis.

AMERICAN RAM INTO FINALS

Ram takes on fellow American for fifth time in career



31-year-old American Rajeev Ram advanced to only his third career ATP World Tour singles final on Saturday after upsetting tournament No. 4 seed and world No. 28 Grigor Dimitrov in straight sets. Ram said the two sets he played against Dimitrov were two of the best of his career as he frustrated the Bulgarian for a 6-4, 6-3 win. Ram's two career ATP titles were both won in Newport, one in 2009 and the other last year. His win over Dimitrov was his second Top 30 win of the tournament as he upset No. 2 seed and world No. 20 Bernard Tomic in the first round. Ram has beaten Querrey once in four tries with the lone win coming in the '09 Newport final when he won his maiden ATP title.

BRYANS RETURN TO TITLE MATCH

Bryan Brothers take on European pair



The Bryan Brothers moved on to their third consecutive final here in Delray Beach after their straight sets semifinal win. They are looking to defend their back-to-back titles and win their fifth career Delray Beach crown as they take on the newly-matched Oliver Marach of Austria and Fabrice Martin of France. The pair joined forces this year, winning their first tournament together in Chennai and forging an 11-4 record. Marach has 14 ATP doubles titles to his name while the triumph in Chennai was Martin's first.
