QUERREY COMES OUT ON TOP

28-year-old American wins first title since 2012



Sunday's final was an All-American affair, with Sam Querrey willing his way to the title over Rajeev Ram 6-4, 7-6(6). The match was as close as the final point, a sizzling forehand by Querrey that caught the back line, but wasn't decided until a Ram challenge confirmed the call. It was

the 28-year-old Querrey's first title since 2012 and eighth overall. The 31-year-old Ram was playing in only the third singles final of his career. Known primarily as a doubles player, he had won his previous two singles finals. This was the first All-American final in Delray Beach since 2003 (Jan-Michael Gambill vs. Mardy Fish) and first American champion since 2009 (Fish).

MARACH & MARTIN WIN 2ND TITLE OF 2016

Bryan Brothers denied chance at a three-peat



Austrian Oliver Marach and Frenchman Fabrice Martin staged a dramatic comeback to beat the Bryan Brothers in Sunday's doubles final, 3-6, 7-6(7) 13-11. After losing the first set, Marach / Martin saved a match point in the second-set tiebreak and then saved five more

match points in the Super Tiebreak. The victory denied the defending champion Bryan Brothers a third straight title here in Delray Beach. The Marach / Martin team won for the second time this year; the crown was the 15th of Marach's career and the second for Martin.

FANS FLOCK TO FINALS

Fifth largest crowd in 24-year watches Sunday's final



Sunday's final drew 4,133 fans, marking it as the fifth largest finals crowd in Delray Beach history. The tournament drew 50,015 fans over 17 sessions for an average of just under 3,000 fans per session. The most-attended day session was Wednesday/Senior Day (3,705)

Senior Day), and the top evening session was Tuesday for the return of Juan Martin del Potro to the ATP World Tour (3,946).
