## 2020 Delray Beach Open

The Delray Beach Open by VITACOST.com, an ATP Tour 250 tournament, returns for its 28th year.

### Champions Clash

The ATP Champions Tour returns to the Delray Beach Open for a 12th edition. The field includes 2006 Delray Beach Open winner **Tommy Haas** along with Champions Tour rookies **Marcos Baghdatis** and **David Ferrer** on Team Europe. They will face Team World which includes Americans **James Blake** and **Vince Spadea**.

### New Addition

For the first time, women's tennis will be featured at the Delray Beach Open, with a special Saturday night exhibition between WTA star and Delray Beach native **Coco Gauff** taking on 2019 NCAA champion **Estela Perez-Somarriba** of the University of Miami.

### International Flavor

A dozen different countries are represented in the main draw singles field at this year's Delray Beach Open. Including the doubles, qualifying and Champions Tour players, there are a total of 26 nations represented this year.

### Age Range

There is a 15-year gap in age between the oldest (35-year-old Andreas Seppi) and youngest (20-year-old Miomir Kecmanovic) players in the singles field. Seppi is one of five 30+ players in the field. Kecmanovic is one of 11 players aged 24 or younger competing this week.

### First Timers

The past two Delray Beach Open champions, **Radu Albot** (2019) and **Frances Tiafoe** (2018), are two of the nine players who have won their maiden ATP title in Delray Beach.

### Winner's Circle

**Radu Albot** will return to the Delray Beach Open as he seeks to be the first player to successfully defend his title here since Jason Stoltenberg in 1996-97. Albot's triumph in 2019 was not only his first career title, but it also marked the first ATP title by a player from Moldova. In what was the first Delray Beach Open final to go three sets since 2008, Albot saved three match points in the against Dan Evans.

### American Accolades

Albot's 2019 title snapped a three-year streak of American winners at the Delray Beach Open. The three year run of American winners included wins by **Frances Tiafoe** (2018), **Jack Sock** (2017) and Sam Querrey (2016). An American has won the Delray Beach Open title seven times in 27 years.

### Been There, Done That

The 2020 Delray Beach Open field includes a the last three tournament champions: **Radu Albot** (2019), **Frances Tiafoe** (2018) and **Jack Sock** (2017). The field also includes one former runner-up in 2016 finalist **Milos Raonic**. Two-time champion **Ernesto Gulbis** (2010, 2013) is participating in qualifying this year.

### Bye-Bye Bryan Brothers

Defending and five-time doubles champions **Bob & Mike Bryan** have announced that 2020 will be their final ATP season. The twins first appeared on the professional scene as wild cards at the 1995 US Open, and made their Delray Beach debut in 1999. They have teamed up to finish as the ATP's No. 1 team 10 times in their career, winning 118 titles and more than 1,100 matches together. They have lifted the Delray Beach Open trophy in 2009, 2010, 2014, 2015 and 2019.

### Title Talk

The Delray Beach Open field includes two players who have already lifted trophies in 2020. France's **Ugo Humbert** won his first career title in Auckland in January while **Jiri Vesely** was victorious in Pune earlier this month.

### Thrill of Victory, Agony of Defeat

**Tennys Sandgren** experienced the joy and pain of sport last month. For the second time in three years, the former University of Tennessee standout reached the Australian Open quarterfinals in a run that included wins over World No. 8 Mario Berrettini and No. 12 Fabio Fognini. He was finally stopped in the quarters by Roger Federer after holding seven match points against 20-time Grand Slam champion. Shortly after that defeat, Sandgren tweeted "What's the rule here folks - a double shot for each match point you didn't convert?"

### Kyrgios Kind to Countrymen

The weeks leading up to the Australian Open were tense times down under as bushfires ravaged many parts of that country. Australian native Nick Kyrgios, a native of Canberra, was quick to support relief efforts by pledging \$200 per ace he hit during the Australian summer tournaments. Numerous players followed suit, as did tennis governing bodies, collectively raising more than \$6 million for the cause.

### Collegiate Champions

This year's Delray Beach Open field features a pair of former NCAA singles champions. **Steve Johnson**, who ended his career at Southern California with a 72-match winning streak, was the 2011 and 2012 NCAA winner. **MacKenzie McDonald** claimed the 2016 NCAA title while playing for UCLA.

### Women's Exhibition Players

**Coco Gauff** is a 15-year-old Delray Beach native ... Will turn 16 on March 13 ... Won first career singles title at Linz in October 2019 ... Youngest player to win a WTA title in 15 years ... Was lucky loser entrant into that event ... Also won a pair of doubles titles in 2019, at Washington, D.C. and Luxembourg, both with Caty McNally ... Broke onto scene by reaching fourth round at 2019 Wimbledon ... Followed up with third round finish at US Open ... In January, reached fourth round at Australian Open ... Lost to eventual champion at both Wimbledon (Simona Halep) and Australian Open (Sofia Kenin) ... In 2018, became youngest Junior No. 1 since ranking system changed in 2004 ... Won 2018 French Open Junior title ... Coached by father, Corey, who played basketball at Georgia State; mother, Candi, excelled in gymnastics before competing in a track and field at Florida State University.

**Estela Perez-Somarrriba** won the NCAA singles title as a University of Miami junior in 2019 ... Currently a senior at Miami ... Has started final campaign with 2-0 singles record ... Won ACC Player of the Year honors as a sophomore and junior ... Also named 2019 ACC Scholar Athlete of the Year ... Reached NCAA Singles semifinals as a freshman ... Has reached at least NCAA Singles Championship Sweet 16 in all three seasons at Miami ... Compiled a 116-20 record in first three seasons at Miami ... 21-year-old is native of Madrid ... Pursuing a major in Economics ... Career goal is to play professional tennis and then own her own business.

**Marcos Baghdatis** (Cyprus) makes Delray Beach Champions Tour debut ... Appeared in 2014 ATP 250 at Delray Beach ... Reached No 8 in ATP Rankings in 2006 ... Won four career titles ... Finalist at 2006 Australian Open ... Owns record 36-match winning streak in Davis Cup ... Retired in 2019 ... No. 1 junior in 2003 after Australian Open title and US Open final.

**David Ferrer** (Spain) is making his debut in Delray Beach ... Achieved career-high No. 3 ranking in 2013 ... Compiled seven Top 10 seasons while being ranked in Top 10 for 292 straight weeks ... Seven-time qualifier at ATP Finals ... Won 27 titles while contesting 52 finals ... Finalist at 2013 French Open ... Reached five other Major semifinals ... Member of three Davis Cup champion teams ... Retired in 2019.

Captain **Tommy Haas** (Germany) is defending champion in his second Champions Tour appearance here ... Won 2006 ATP title here and was 11-8 in his career in Delray Beach ... Was ranked as high as No. 2 in his career ... Won 15 singles titles and appeared in 13 other finals ... A three-time Australian Open semifinalist, also reached one Wimbledon semifinal ... Owns at least three career wins over Agassi, Djokovic, Federer and Sampras ... Won Silver Medal at 2000 Sydney Olympics ... Retired in 2018.

**Mikael Pernfors** (Sweden) is making fifth Champions Tour appearance here after playing the 1993 ATP event ... Reached Top 10 in 1986 after reaching French Open final ... Won three singles titles in career ... Winner of back-to-back NCAA Singles Championships for University of Georgia in 1984-85 ... Bulldogs won NCAA Team title in 1985 ... Retired in 1998.

### Champions Tour Team World

Captain **James Blake** (USA) is making fourth Champions Tour appearance here after playing ATP 250 event seven times ... Won 2013 doubles title with Jack Sock ... Reached career high ranking of No. 4 ... Claimed 10 titles in career ... Three-time quarterfinalist at US Open, also reached final eight at Australian Open ... Named 2008 ATP Arthur Ashe Humanitarian of the Year ... Played collegiately at Harvard, reaching No. 1 ranking and NCAA Singles Final ... Retired in 2013.

**Johan Kriek** (South Africa) is making third Champions Tour appearance in Delray Beach ... Was ranked as high as No. 7 in singles and No. 12 in doubles ... Won consecutive Australian Open titles in 1981-82 ... Owns 14 career ATP titles while reaching 13 other finals ... Last season on ATP was 1991, though last tour event in doubles in Delray Beach in 1999.

**Jesse Levine** (Canada) is making third Champions Tour appearance at Delray Beach after playing ATP 250 four times ... Owns five career Challenger titles while finishing runner-up on three other occasions ... Was an All-American at the University of Florida as a freshman, earning National Rookie of the Year with a 21-0 record ... Director of Tennis at the Delray Beach Club ... Retired in 2013.

**Vince Spadea** (USA) is a Boca Raton resident who is playing second Champions Tour event after a dozen ATP 250 appearances ... Reached 2004 Delray Beach final ... Achieved career high ranking of No. 18 in 2005 ... Won lone career singles title at Scottsdale in 2004 ... As a junior, was 1992 Orange Bowl champion and reached No. 4 in rankings ... Last full ATP season was 2009.

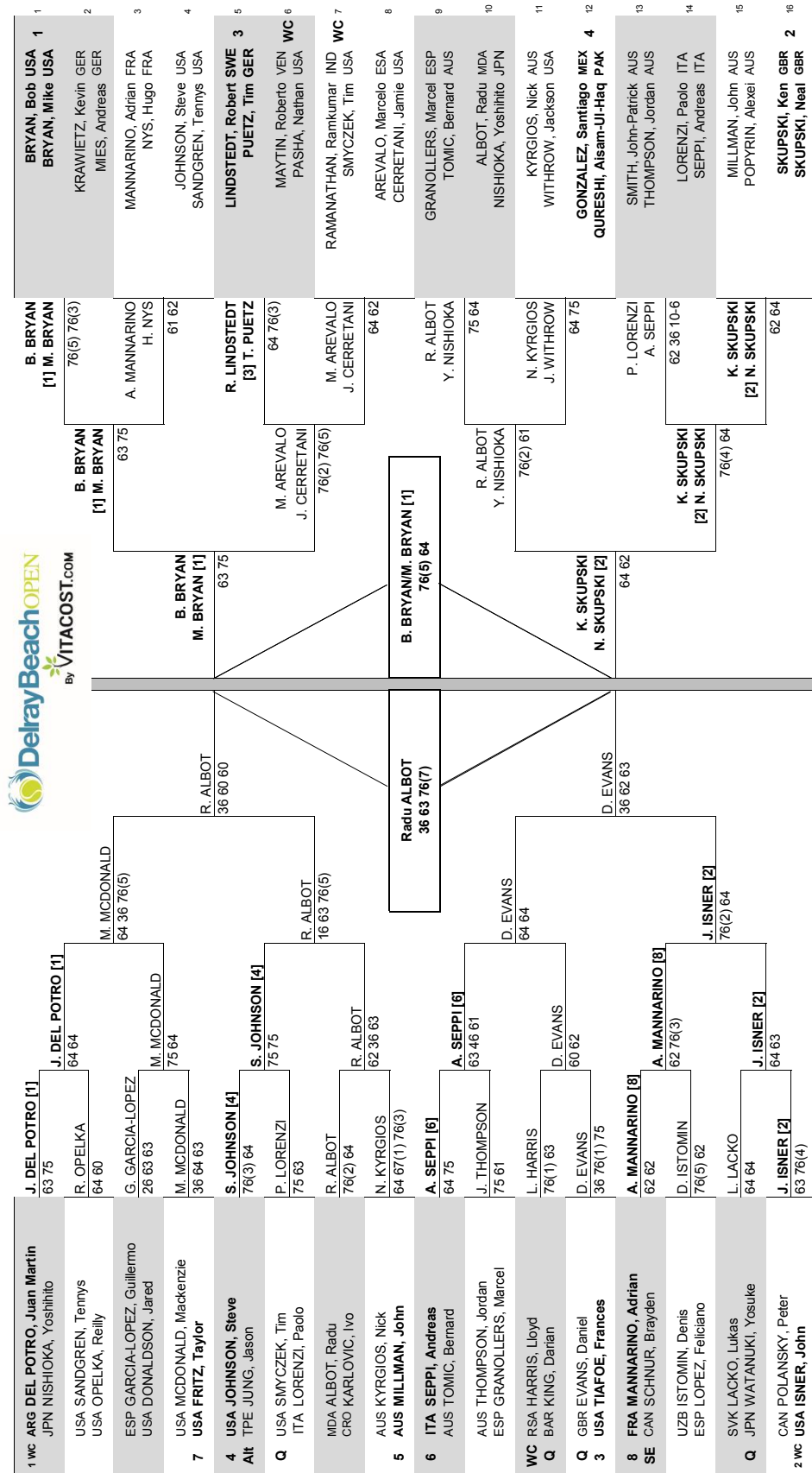
